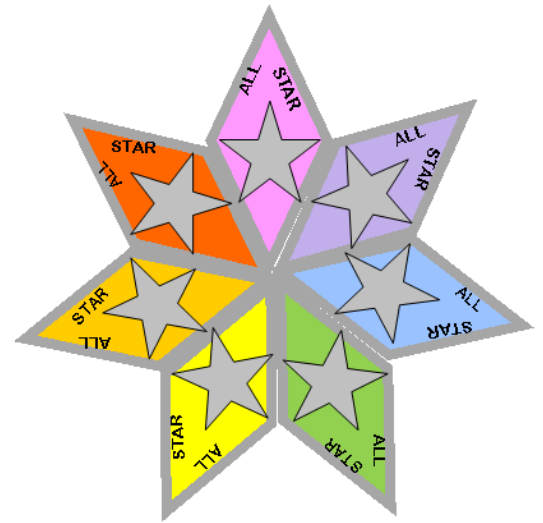




Troop/Group All Star Award
