

Policy Statement: It is the policy of Girl Scouts of Historic Georgia, Inc. that no girl be denied participation in Girl Scouting due to financial reasons. Any girl who cannot participate or be a member because of finances may apply for financial assistance for her membership fee, event fees, and/or camp fees.

Financial Aid for girls and adults is made possible through generous gifts from individuals, corporations, and foundations. Financial Aid is available for Girl Scout membership fees, Girl Scout publications, GSUSA insignia, and uniform components.

Amount of grant awarded will be based on:

- girl's/family's involvement in Girl Scouting
- number of applications received
- available funds

Financial Aid may be available for active Girl Scout adults' membership or training fees.

A parent/guardian, troop/group leader, or other appropriate adult may initiate a request for Financial Aid. The Council will notify the initiator of the amount of assistance to be awarded per a standard formula applied to all requests.

The Financial Aid application must be completed in its entirety and signed by the parent, troop leader, or council staff person.

No application will be considered unless the application is completed in full and has the proper signatures.

If you wish to apply for Financial Aid, please complete the following steps:

1. Complete and sign a Financial Aid application. No application will be processed unless the complete information is provided.
2. Return the completed form to your troop leader or a council staff member.
3. The council staff member will complete her portion and submit the application to her local Council Registrar for processing.
4. A completed girl/adult GSUSA registration form should be attached to the Financial Aid application.

- Remember, girls have the opportunity to earn troop money through the Fall Product Sale and Cookie Sale. They can then use this money to pay for membership and attend programs or camp.
